



# MY PUZZLE ADVENTURE

## HOW DOES IT WORK ?

### 1 Build the jigsaw puzzle

Build the big picture with the 42 jigsaw pieces. You can use the back of this rule as a model.

Try not to look at the backs of the pieces.



### 2 How to play ? (before your first run)

During the game, you have to find a specific piece of the jigsaw puzzle based on clues. The piece is then picked up, turned over and read out.

Example of clues :



Go to the dragon.

In this example, Arnaud starts looking for the piece with the dragon on it in the jigsaw.

The pieces are numbered on their back. They must be found in the following order:



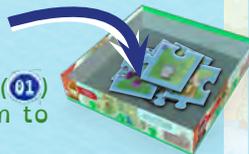
Arnaud thinks he has found the right piece, so he turns it over and reveals the number (02). It's the right one! Well done Arnaud!

**If you find the wrong number :** simply put the piece back in its place in the jigsaw puzzle (without reading it and with the back on the table). Then continue your search !

When you find the right piece, put the previous piece back in the box before reading your new clue.

Arnaud has found the piece (02). So he puts the piece (01) back in the box before reading the clue that will lead him to the piece (03).

Keep going until you've put the whole jigsaw in the box!



### 3 Choose your character

Have you understood all the rules? Is your jigsaw puzzle done? Read the introduction and discover the story!
